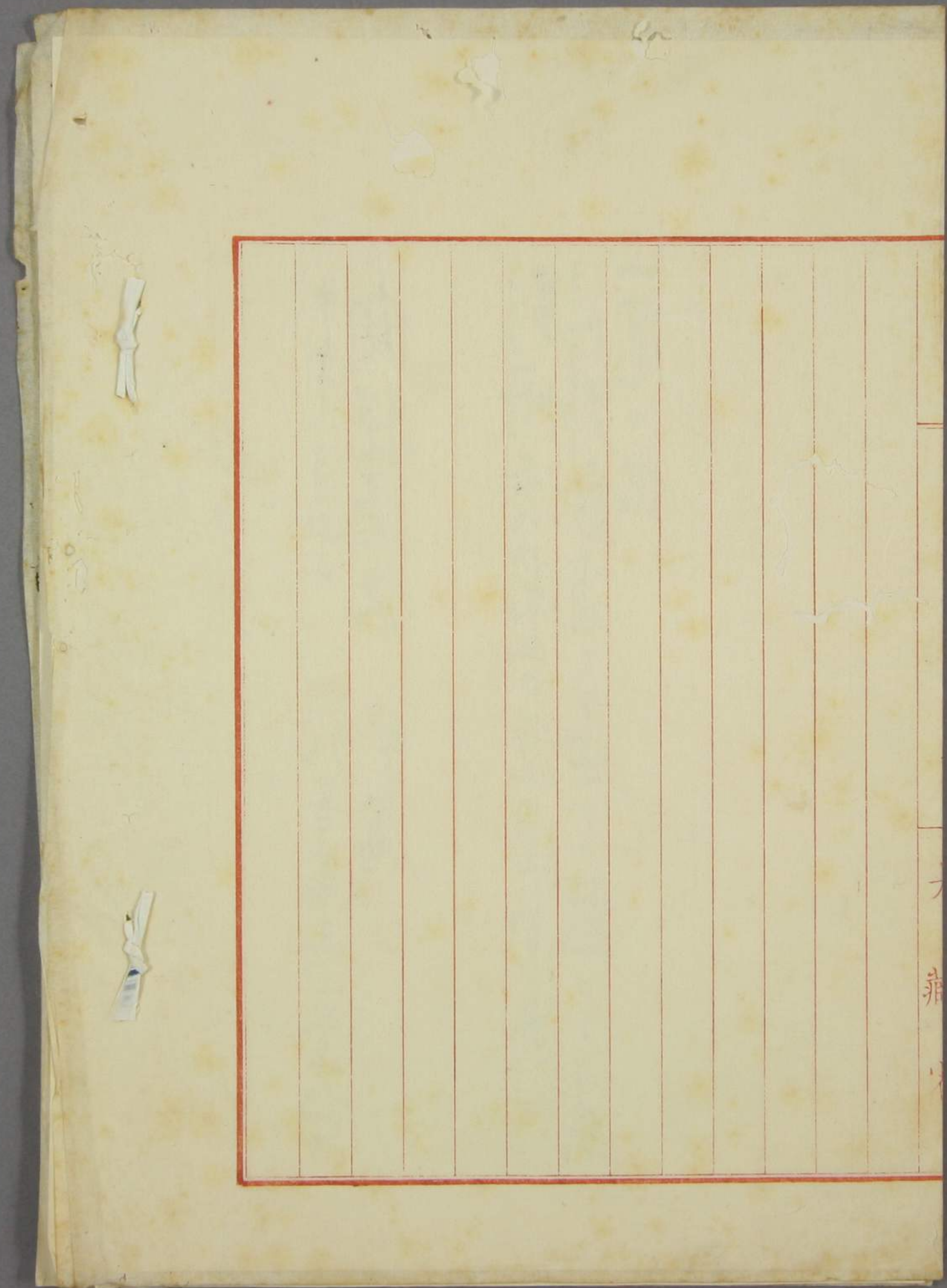

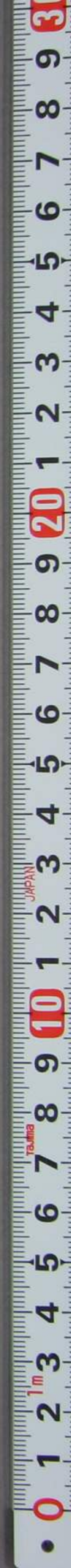

The Sorts imported, and the estimated Values, are shown in the Table below. All the Opium imported into China reaches it through Hongkong. As the quantity consumed there is comparatively trifling, the amount brought into China in Native vessels, and which consequently does not appear in these Returns, must be nearly equal to the quantity by which the Hongkong importation exceeds the entries at the Treaty Ports. A deduction must be made from this, for the amount sent to California for the use of the Chinese there. This has been for the last eight years as follows:—
