A sketch of the Sialiao anchorage taken by the master of the U. S. S. "Ashuelot" on the 2nd of March, 1872, is herewith transmitted, with the recommendation that it be engraved and distributed among the masters of the various transports or vessels attached to the Expedition. A reference to this sketch and the directions attached thereto will enable the ship-masters to find the Sialiao Anchorage, where the expedition is to rendezvous, in case, going there by themselves, they should be unable to find a pilot, or, in a storm,

should become accidentally
separated from the rest of
the fleet on their way down
to that place from Nagasaki.
