At its decennial reunion in New Brunswick, on June 20, 1899, the Class of 1889 of Rutgers College directed that the funds in possession of the Treasurer of the Class be paid over to the Trustees of the College with instructions to use the interest only for general purposes; and that until further instructions, that the principal be considered as a part of the General Endowment Fund of the College.

The members voted to express to the Trustees through their Secretary their earnest hope that an Endowment Fund for 'Emeritus Professorships' be established.

The sentiment of the Class expressed by vote was that each member try to subscribe \$10 or more on or before December 1 of each year for the next ten years.

The following officers were elected: President, Morris; Vice-President, Anderson; Secretary-Treasurer, Myers; who with Street will constitute the Executive Committee of the Class.

A vote was passed requesting each member to send his present address to the Treasurer of the Class and to give prompt notice of any change of residence.

The sum of one hundred dollars has been turned over to the College Trustees, and the members of the Class who have not subscribed are urged to subscribe as soon as possible for the year 1899 in order that another hundred dollars may be turned over to the College during this year.

A statement will be sent at the close of this year to the members of the Class, and it is suggested that every one be present at the meeting next January of the Alumni Association in New York, in order that the '89 men may keep better in touch with each other and in sympathy with the Old College.
