

My dear O<sup>1</sup> Kuma,

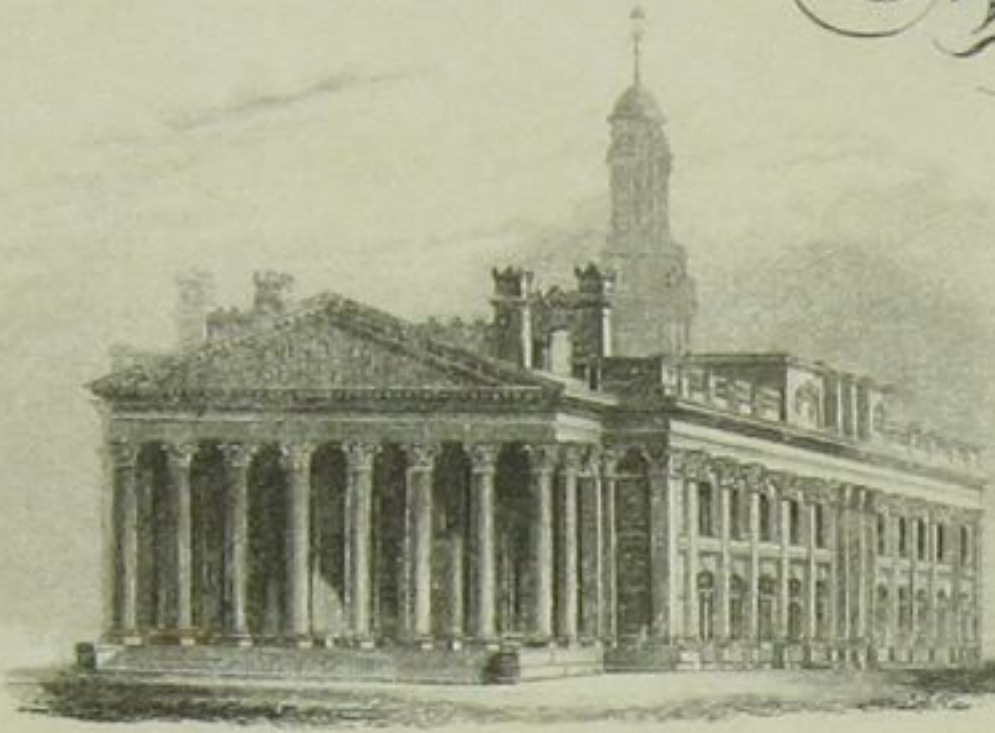

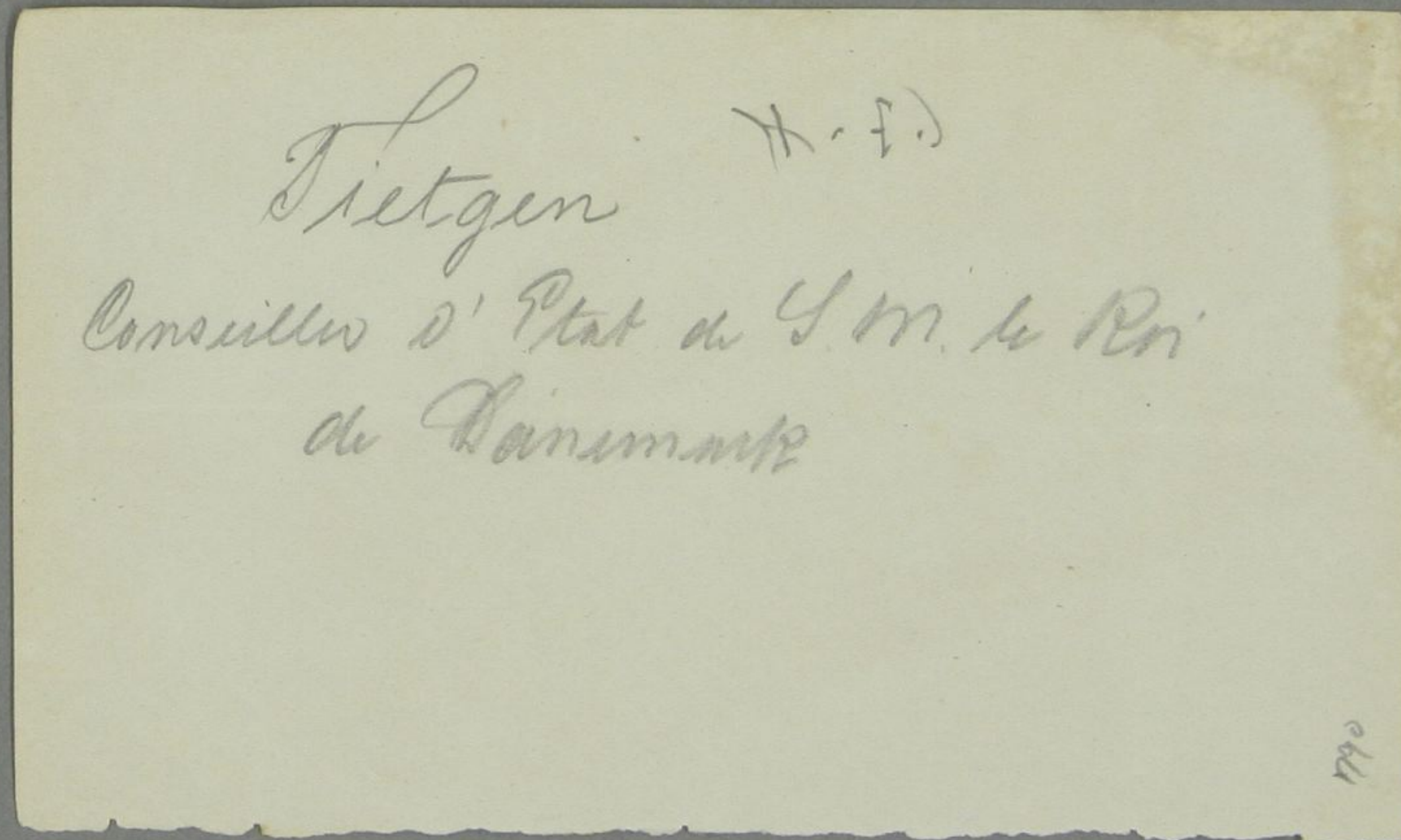
