

Eight hundred and Sixty thousand Mexican
 dollars to be paid in London or Yokohama as
 convenient to Mr. Okuma - To be repaid in rice
 through Mitsui, as arranged, at the rate of
 one Rikie farral measure pro \$1.30 - The
 rice to be good South Country quality, and
 to be delivered at any time or in any quantity
 convenient to the buyers, at either Yokohama,
 Ondo, Osaka, or Kobe. If Mr. Okuma takes
 the above sum of money before the rice is delivered,
 interest will be charged at the rate of 6% annum
 to stop when the rice is taken delivery of.
 If good profit is made on the rice
 half will be given back to Government.
